**Ring One (Top)**

- 09.00** Clear Round Jumping 80cms will close at **09.50** £5 per round to be paid at ring
- 10.15** Class 1A: Senior Novice Show Jumping – 80cms\*  
All clubs in Section A will automatically be entered in Sec B.
- Class 1B: Qualifier for London & South East Championships  
No Preliminary Entry to BRC is required for Clubs entering teams in Sec B only.

**Ring Three (Bottom)**

- 09.00** Clear Round Jumping 80cms will close at **09.40** £5 per round to be paid at ring
- 10.00** Class 2: Junior Novice Show Jumping – 80cms\*  
Class 3: Senior Intermediate Show Jumping – 95cms\*

**Ring Two (Middle)**

- 09.30** Class 4: Junior Style Jumping  
Class 5: Senior Style Jumping
- Approx 13.00** Clear Round Jumping 95cms will close at **13.45** £5 per round to be paid at ring
- 14.00** Class 6: Junior Intermediate Show Jumping – 95cms\*  
Class 7: Senior Open Show Jumping – 1.1m\*

\* denotes first round max. height

## **General Rules & Conditions of Entry Run under British Riding Club Rules 2011**

1. **Equine Influenza Certificate** – all competitors in the Riding Club Qualifiers must have an up to date Equine Influenza Certificate, which must, under penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to this competition. The competitor is responsible for producing it when collecting their number. In addition a photocopy must be sent to the Entries Secretary with the Official Entry Form. Photocopies need not be sent for any horse confirmed as listed on the 2011 Database
2. **Membership Cards:** To be produced when collecting number.
3. **Horse-box Sign:** Please clearly display an A4 sign inside the windscreen of your vehicle with your Club Name; your Name & contact number for the day. This is so we can contact you in an emergency.
4. All entries are accepted only upon the terms of the general rules and the conditions below. Your signature on the entry form shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the rules and conditions.
5. The judges' decisions are final.
6. In the event of cancellation, £2 shall be retained for each competitor to cover admin expenses.
7. **Health & Safety** – The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
8. **Disclaimer of Liability** – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
9. **Protective Headgear** – must be worn at all times by anyone, whether or not a competitor, riding anywhere at a BRC event. Harnesses must be correctly adjusted and fastened. "Protective Headwear" constitutes a hat which meets one of the following standards.  
British PAS 015, BSEN1384 Provided BSI Kitemarked or SEI  
European EN1384 Provided BSI Kitemarked or SEI  
American All All SEI ASTM 95, ASTM F1163, SNELL E2001  
Australian & New Zealand All SAI AS/NZS 3838  
Failure to do so will incur elimination. Skull cap hats must be worn with a silk.
10. All lorries & trailers must be parked in an orderly fashion in the designated parking areas only.
11. All dogs must be kept on leads.
12. **Scoring Enquiries or Objections** must be made by a Club's Chef d'Equipe, Chairman or authorised representative.
