

MDRC HEALTH & SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present.

For these measures to be effective, **everyone** must take due care and precaution to avoid accidents. They must obey instructions from organisers, officials and stewards at the event.

- Emergency services must have access at **all** times to **all** areas in use.
- In case of an emergency contact an official, organiser or steward. Or dial 999 giving address.
- Correct dress must be worn in **all** classes and British standard hard hats EN1384, PAS015 or with a prefix ASTM or SEI must be worn at **all** times when mounted, with the harness properly adjusted and fastened.
- Horses can be dangerous and easily frightened. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas and refrain from behaviour which could alarm horses.
- Dogs must be under control at all times. Please check that they are welcome at the venue before bringing them.
- The welfare of the horse is a priority and will be treated as such in the event of mistreatment and malpractice with spurs, whips, etc.
- By entering Riding Club competitions it will be deemed that riders are fit to partake and they consent to treatment advice offered or given by the officiating First Aid team.

PLEASE NOTE THE ORGANISERS DO NOT HOLD THEMSELVES RESPONSIBLE FOR ANYTHING THAT MAY HAPPEN TO COMPETITORS, ONLOOKERS OR ANY OTHER PERSON, THEIR PROPERTY, SERVANTS OR HORSES, IN CONNECTION WITH OR ARISING FROM THIS EVENTS AND IT SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY THAT EACH ENTRANT SHALL AGREE TO INDEMNIFY THE ORGANISERS AGAINST ANY LEGAL ACTION.
